

Camillus House and Miami Supportive Housing proudly announce the grand opening of new permanent housing program

On Wednesday, February 16th Camillus House and Miami Supportive Housing will host the grand opening and dedication of the Brownsville Christian Housing Center. The new 74-unit housing program will provide a home for adult men and women who have come through Miami-Dade County's Continuum of Care for homeless persons, and who are now ready to live on their own in a permanent housing setting but cannot afford unsubsidized housing.

The housing program is located in the former and recently renovated "Christian Hospital" a historic property with a rich past, as it was Miami's first hospital serving the African-American community.

The opening of this facility brings to fruition a long-standing desire of the community to convert the property into low-income housing, allowing its residents to live productive and dignified lives, while receiving a range of services in a safe and supportive environment. Development of the housing facility began more than 10 years ago and was taken over and completed by Miami Supportive Housing, who has turned it over to Camillus House for operations administration.

Camillus House and Miami Supportive Housing wish to thank the community for helping make this housing dream a reality that will benefit many individuals.
